#### The OCCC Board is Considering a Tuition Increase

- Effective beginning Fall 2019
- \$2 to \$6 per credit increase to maintain the current levels of services to students (& replace SharkNET)
- Last tuition increase was in 2011
- Last fee increase in 2016 brought new services to students





# Sample Cost Escalators for the College (2016 to 2017)

- PERS & Health Insurance (12%)
- Facilities & Information Technology (4%)
- Annual Salary Increases (2%)
