Potential New Program List for Consideration & Review

The College mission calls upon us to provide educational pathways in response to the diverse needs of our community. The Strategic Plan calls for our growth in the realm of 500 new FTE over the next five years. This will include growth in both transfer and CTE programming in the years to come.

The Executive Team has developed an initial list of potential new programs based on:

- Data from a variety of labor projections and reports
- Community needs consistently expressed (i.e. across multiple sources).
- Consideration of existing programs (effort to avoid duplication)

We anticipate further additions to this list as we seek input from stakeholders. During the summer we will develop and apply an initial rubric to consider demand and feasibility. The goal is to narrow this list to those programs which meet community needs, will have sustained enrollment, and will be financially sustainable for the college over the long run. The intent is to select and develop an overall mix of programs that will augment and contribute to current offerings to reach the goal of 1000 FTE by 2020 and further reduce the overall cost per FTE of the college as a whole.
