



It feels very much the same as high school, except everything seems more laid back.



Again; Very comfortable while attending classes in person before stay at home; uncomfortable now for Spring term.


I prefer more of an in-person experience, but I'm becoming much more used to college classes now.

If anything, diversity makes me feel more comfortable even though I identify as "Caucasian/white" on all documents asking for racial information.


Strange, but I guess still an unfortunate important question; aren't we all humans of infinite variety??!!




Honestly, I don't know many of the staffs sexual orientation, and frankly it doesn't matter to me.


While I don't agree with it, I have not had any problems with their choice.


There needs to be more resources for students with disabilities. We are the only college without an ASL class. I am half deaf and have never had any resources to reach out too.
