# College Updates

## Nursing & Allied Health Update

- Nursing application is open- now through March 31, 2023. Number of applicants is increasing.
- Current Enrollment numbers:
  - 1st year nursing - 28
  - 2nd year nursing - 23
  - Medical Assistant - 3
  - EMT - 8
- Spring term - High School Nursing Assistant will be offered, enrolling up to 10 students.
- The new NCLEX exam becomes effective on April 1, 2023. Our graduates will be some of the first to complete this exam. We are expecting a drop in NCLEX pass rates but are taking proactive steps to prepare students for this exam.



- Nursing students have invested over 5,000 hours toward COVID-19 vaccination efforts in Lincoln County.
- Community service projects include a recent Homeless Connect event.





# College Updates

## Nursing & Allied Health Update

- Buildout of North Campus labs is ongoing, providing new equipment and more capacity for labs and simulation.
- Our clinical partners have all expressed interest in hiring our new graduate nurses before they graduate in June. We are confident that all 23 graduates will have a job at the time of graduation.
- The Oregon State Board of Nursing has approved
  - LPN-RN Bridge program (summer start?)
  - 30% increase enrollment in the nursing program, admit 40 nursing students for fall.

- Dr. Crystal Bowman and Megan Cawley (Nursing Faculty) will be presenting  
**"Mentorship Within Nursing & Allied Health – A Retention Model"**  
at the Oregon CTE conference.





# AQS Update

- Larry Boles (AQS Program Director), Dan Lara (VP of Academic Affairs), and Trevor Erdmann (PT AQS Faculty) were awarded one of 11 slots in the National Science Foundation's Mentor-Connect program.
- The grant funds travel to workshops and provides online mentoring to assist with preparation of an NSF Advance Technology Education grant to be submitted in October 2023.
- If awarded, the ATE grant will provide approximately \$350,000 to expand the Aquarium Science program to include courses related to emerging technologies in aquaculture and live seafood holding.





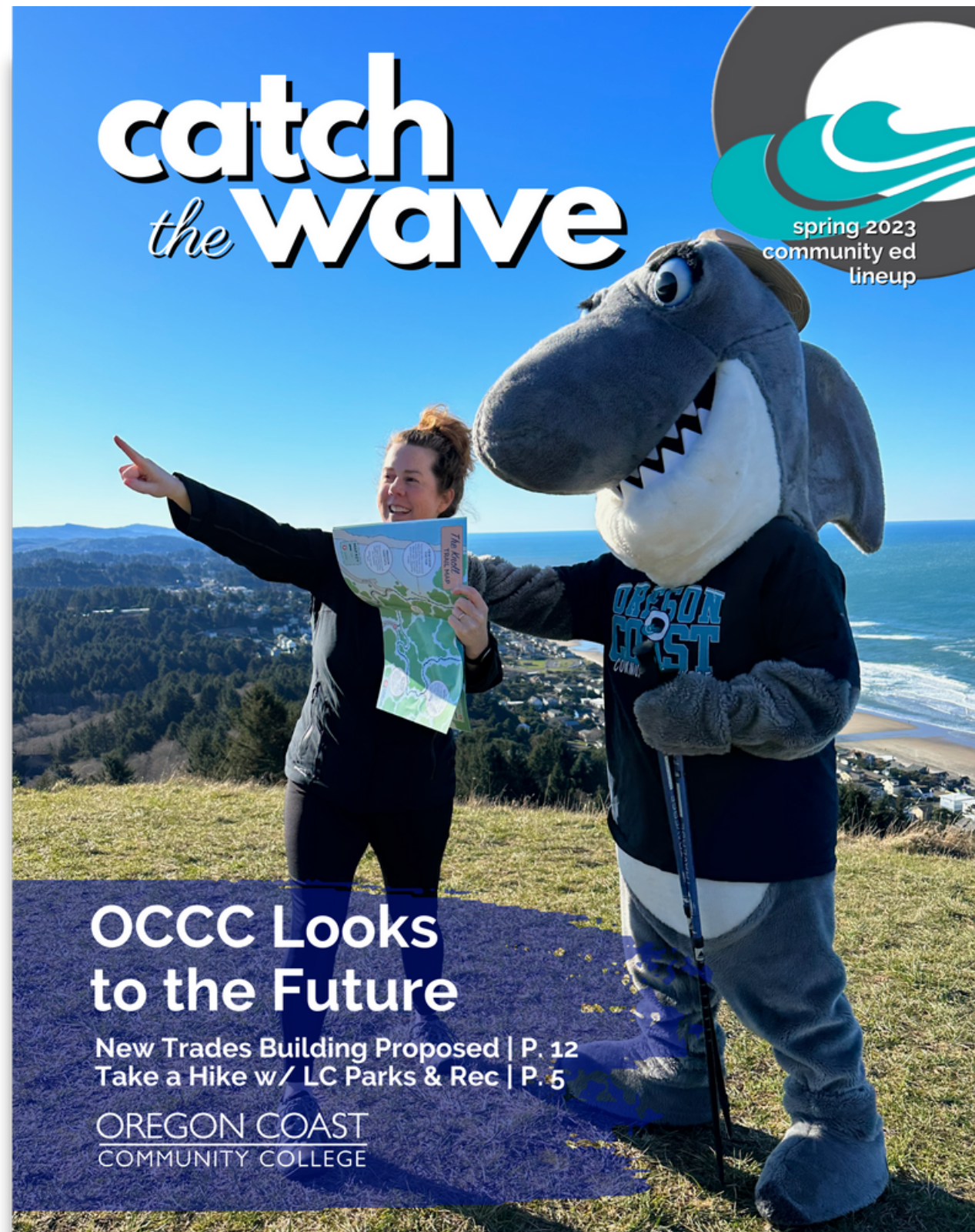
