2023 Legislative Session

The Oregon Community College Association (OCCA) Board of Directors identified three legislative priorities for the 2023 Session. They were:

- Community College Support Fund of \$855 million with \$50 million in one-time funding
- Doubling of the Oregon Opportunity Grant to \$415 million
- Passage of legislation to empower community colleges to offer Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degrees.

Outcomes

- Ultimately, legislators funded the Community College Support Fund at \$800 million and made a significant \$100 million investment in the Oregon Opportunity Grant.
- SB 523 went on to pass unanimously in both the state House and Senate.
- The Governor's Recommended Budget (GRB) reauthorized only three of the six community college capital construction projects (OCCC was left out).....

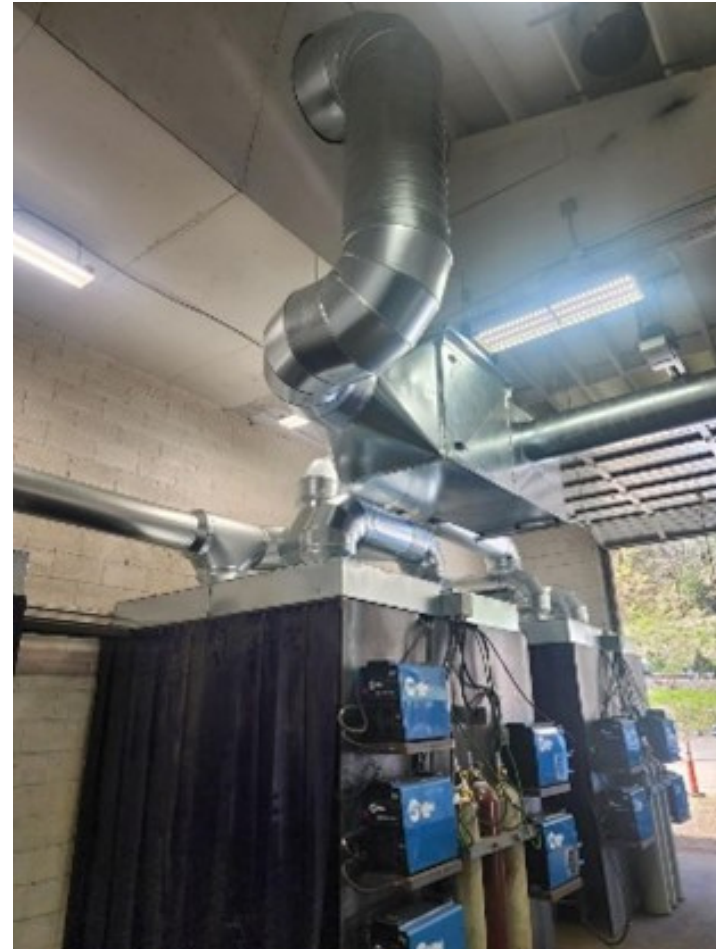

Welding Program Update

- Welding Lab Ventilation was installed at the Port of Toledo through funds from the Future Ready Oregon Pathways grant.
- The funding also allowed the expansion into an additional bay, increasing the number of welding stations (seats) at the Port of Toledo from 12 to 18.



- A new Computer Numerical Control (CNC) plasma cutter was purchased. Will be ready for use in the Fall '23 Term.

LPN and RN Program Update

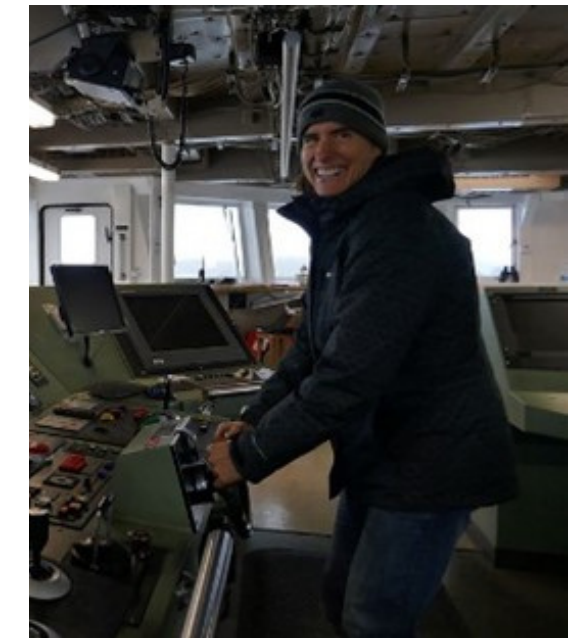


- The Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN) has approved the expansion of seats in the RN program from 30 to 40.
- OSBN also approved the reinstatement of LPN to RN pathway.



- Enrollment: 38 first year nursing students, 18 LPNs joining the 22 second year nursing students for a potential graduating class of **40 nurses!**
- Nursing Sim Lab at North Center. This is **half** of the \$250,000 equipment expenditure ready for installation.

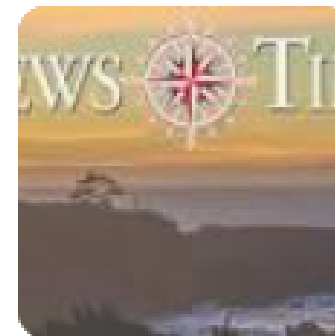

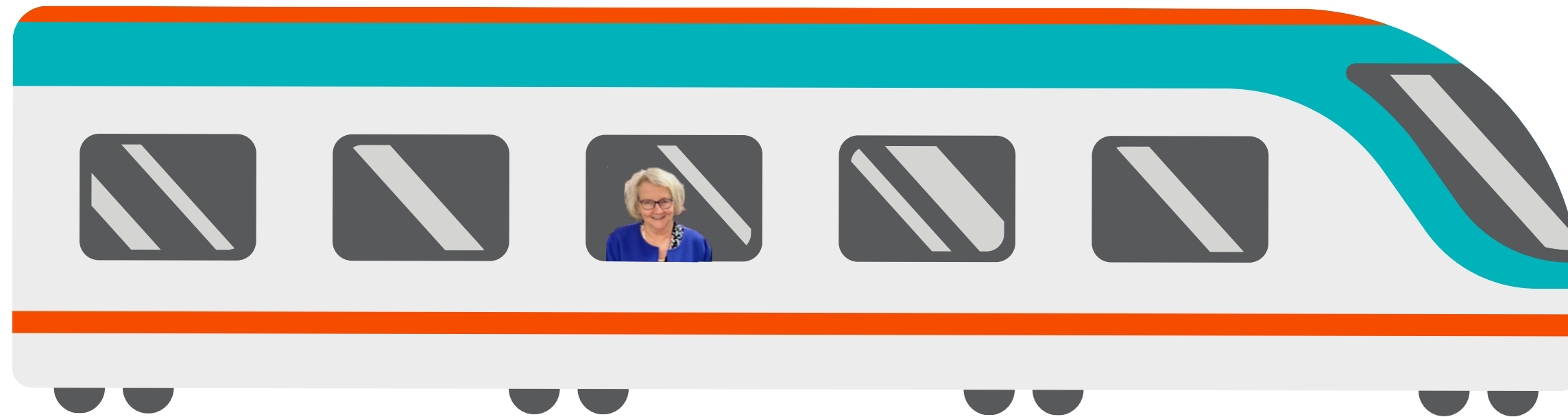

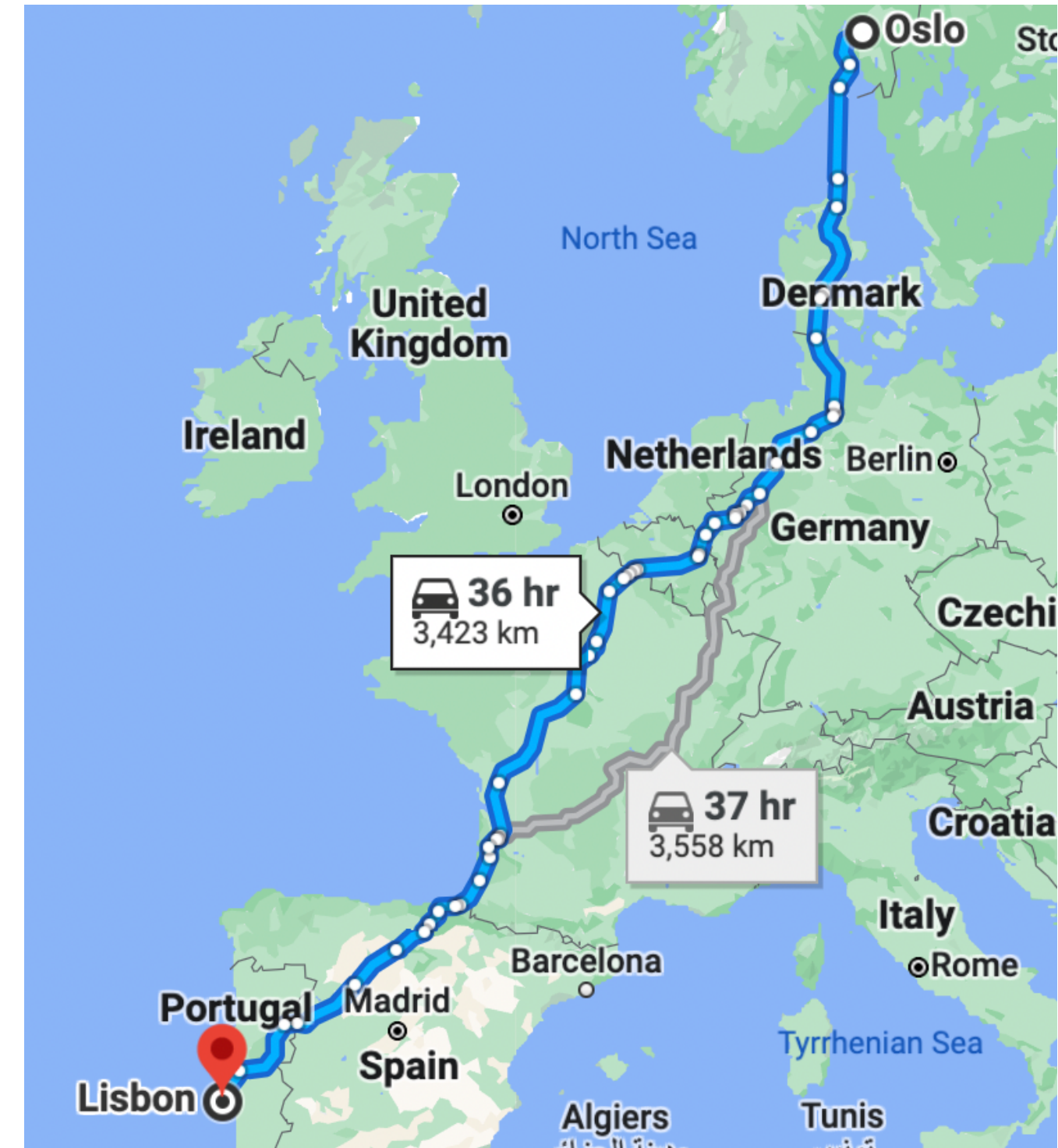
