


Phishing Activities

- Email Phishing attacks: Barracuda
 - Increased Activity
 - Spear Phishing (Targeted individuals or groups)
 - Site Spoofing (Links that aren't what they say they are)
- Phishing Testing and Training: KnowBe4
 - Weekly Phishing Test
 - Automated Training
 - Phone email can be problematic



Multi-Factor Authentication

- Uses Cell Phone or One-Time Password (OTP) Token
 - Things You Know (Passwords, PINs, etc.)
 - Things You Have (Cell Phone, OTP)
 - Things You Are (Fingerprint, Facial Scan)
- Cuts Identify Theft By 99.9%
- Required By Insurance
- Easy To Do, Provides Peace of Mind
