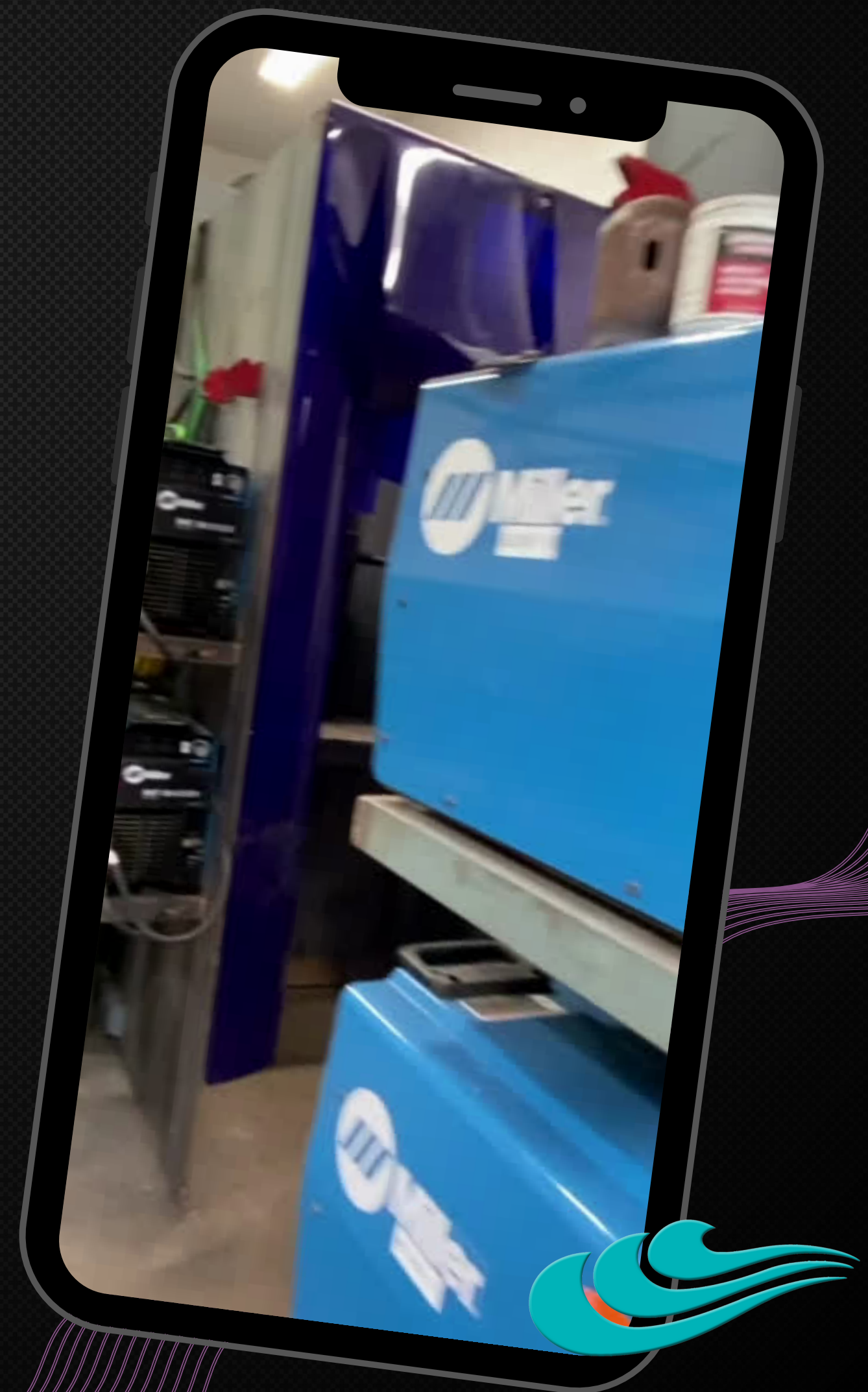

OCCC has received Fed & State approval for 48-credit **Welding Certificate** and four mini-certificates

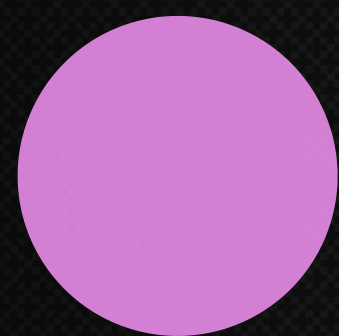
