- President's update – Birgitte Ryslinge (absent) Andres Oroz
  - **OCCC's Spring 2024 In-Service: Taking Care of Students and Taking Care of Ourselves – Four Pillars of Lifestyle Medicine** was a definite success. Thank you to the committee and the people who organized and delivered this event.
  - **Nursing Exceeds NCLEX Rates since 2020.** Dr. Bowman has received the annual National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) reports published by the National Council for State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN). This data profiles the already strong Nursing Program of OCCC has continued to expand its success as measured by NCLEX pass rates. Here are a couple of highlights from the data:
    - Percentage of graduates passing NCLEX on the FIRST attempt: in 2020 our program was ranked 27<sup>th</sup> out of 28 in the state of Oregon. We are now ranked **19<sup>th</sup> out of 30** (54% improvement).
    - Most recent pass rates: Our current pass rate is **95.24%** - this is the highest passing rate in the history of the program.Please congratulate Dr. Bowman and all of the wonderful Nursing faculty and staff that lead and support this impactful program.
  - **Celebrateus 2024 Friday June 7, 2024 11:00 am-1:00 pm**
    - Celebrateus is an OCCC Employee award event. Students select the Instructor of the Year, and the recipient is announced at Cellebrateus.
