 - The current number of enrollments is up over 15%; we have 1 FTE more than our final fall FTE for 2023. More registrations are coming in from community education, GED and ESOL.

Action Items

- BSN Curriculum Crystal Bowman
 - Started 18 months ago with this idea from a few community colleges that wanted to move forward with the BSN Degree program. Objections from bigger colleges at first, but they brought back the bill, went through the legislative process and it passed. Now they are going through the approval stages and have a target date of Fall 2026 to open our doors.
 - OCCC is working with 5 other colleges and when approved, each college will be able to offer 7 seats.
 - BSN Degree admitted students will have completed an Assoc of Applied Science or Associate of Science degree and passed the NCLEX-RN exam by the end of the first quarter of courses, if not sooner. The program focuses on advanced nursing courses that prepare the BSN student for various roles within healthcare.
 - Ten Program Outcomes
 - Course Sequencing Math and Biology is built in
 - General Education and Related Instruction Need to have Arts & Letters and Social Sciences
 - Different courses
