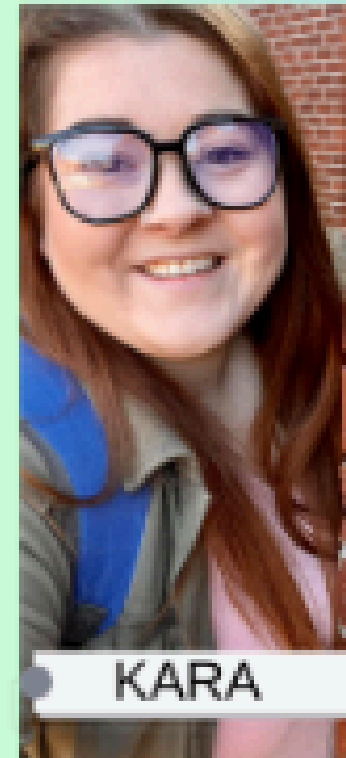


GAEL

DELAYNA

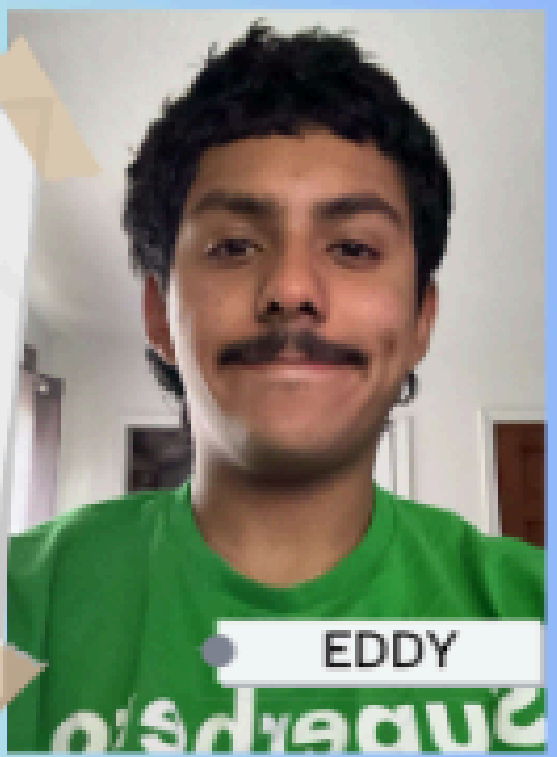

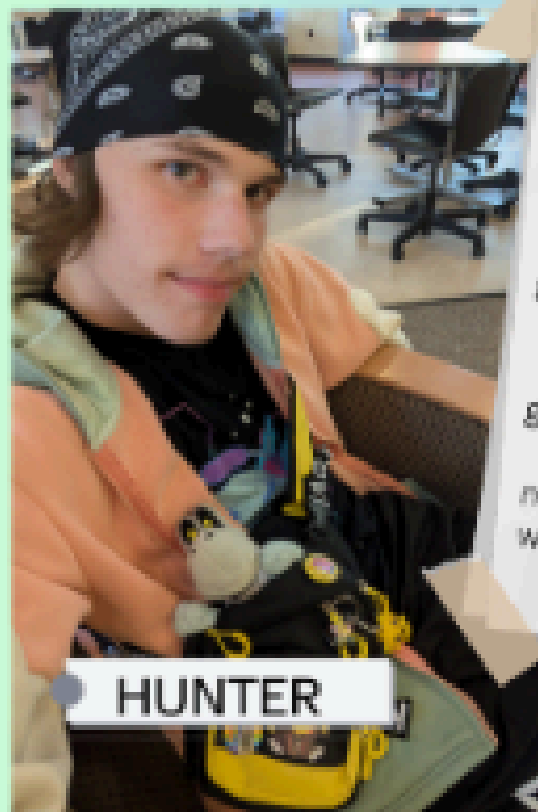
KARA

EDDY

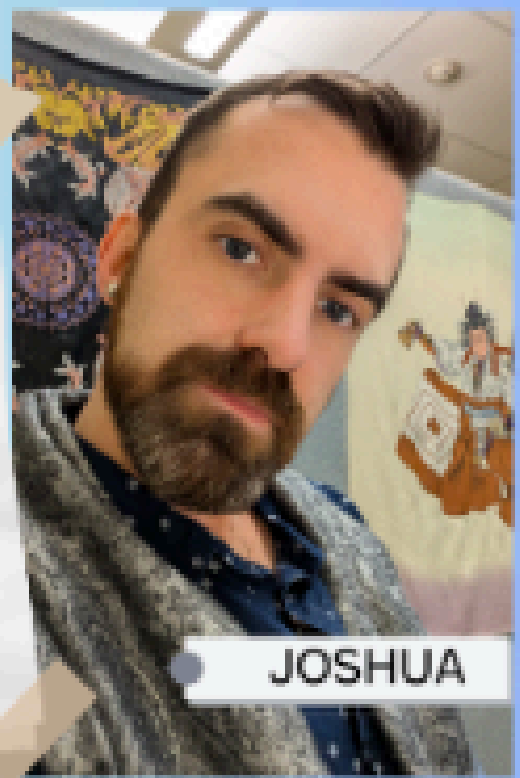
