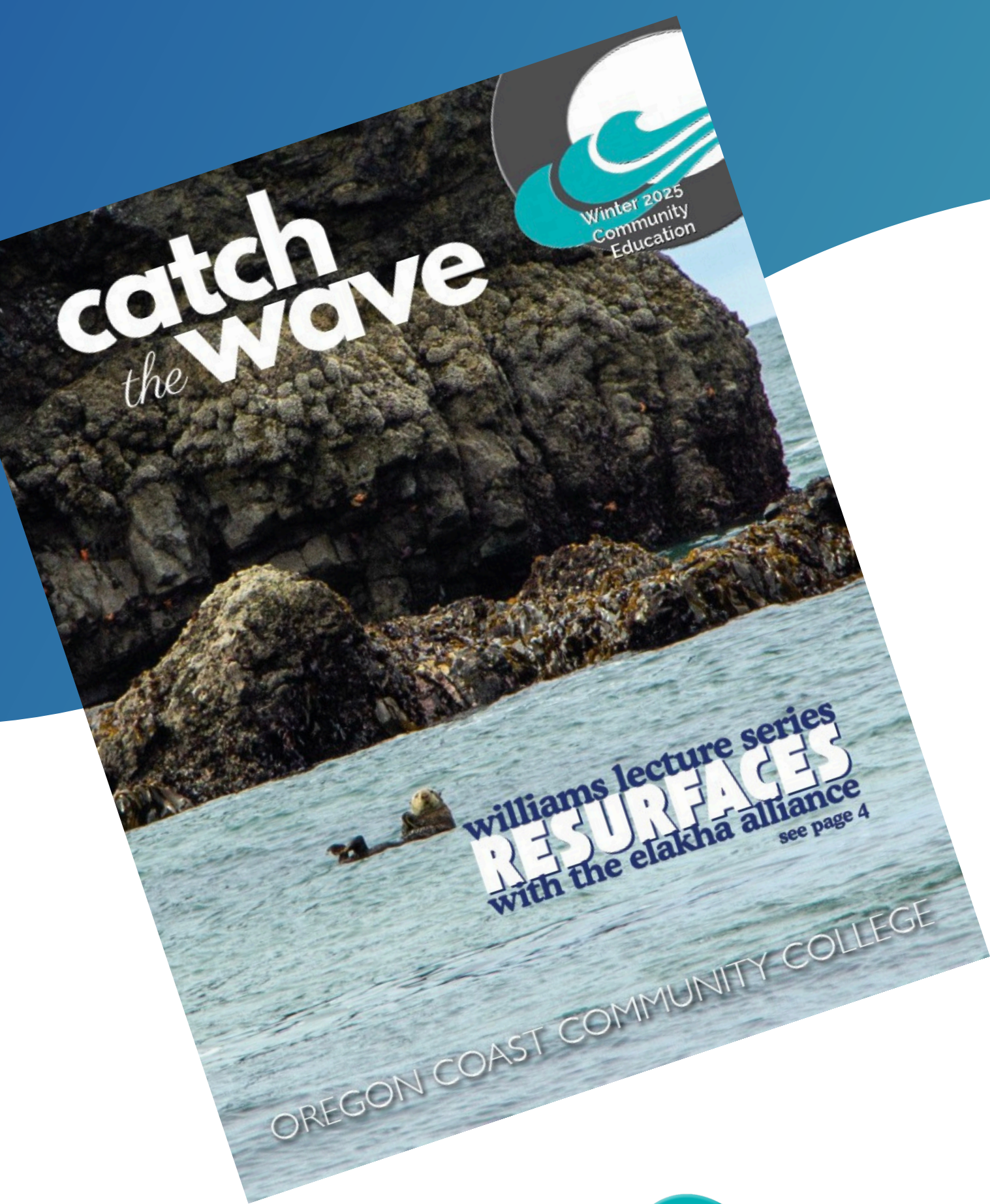
Informed Decision: Gather information to see if the program aligns with your goals.

- This open advising session is for returning students who have previously registered at OCCC.

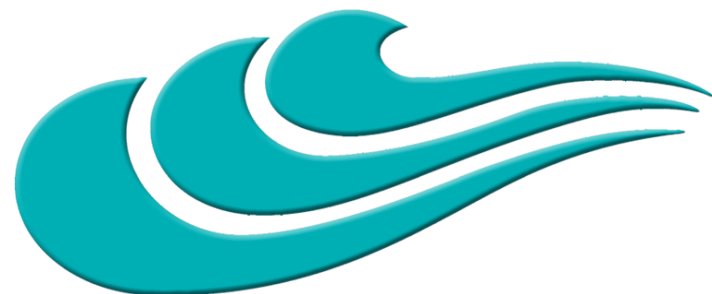

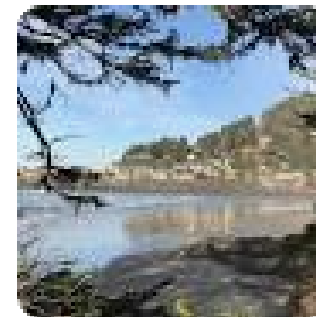

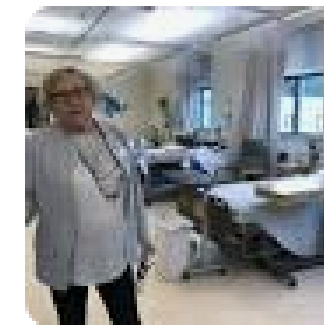
