

Advising Requirement – LPN-RN Prospective Students & Applicants

Please complete the following items before making an advising appointment. Current OCCC students who have been working closely with the nursing & allied health advisor do not need to complete these items, but they may be helpful to review.

Apply to OCCC	Please enter "associate of general studies" for your program if the nursing application is not yet open. After receiving the welcome email from our college follow the instructions to set up your college email and accounts.
Transcript Evaluation *Only for students who have previous college credits.	Follow the <u>transcript evaluation process</u> to see what credits you have. The two key steps are sending over your official transcripts to <u>registrar@oregoncoast.edu</u> and then filling out the evaluation request <u>form</u> . When the evaluation is complete, the registrar will let you know if there are

any remaining requirements left for your pathway. *Please note: OCCC only accepts transcripts from regionally accredited institutions.

Key Requirements	The major prerequisite to applying is that you must have an active LPN license in the state of Oregon. Additionally, having a social science class (ex: Sociology, Psychology, Anthropology, Poli Sci, History, and others) and an arts & letters class (ex: Literature, Speech, Music, Art, Philosophy, Religion, Communication and 200-Level Language) can help you get extra points on your application and are required to graduate from the program if accepted. Additional requirements and information will be listed on the application when it opens. *Please note: OCCC only accepts transcripts from regionally accredited institutions.
Additional Information	Nursing classes will be held on-site at our Newport and Lincoln City campuses. Clinicals will also be on- site in Lincoln County. You will need to plan on being here at least 4 days a week through mid-June, except for breaks between terms.
