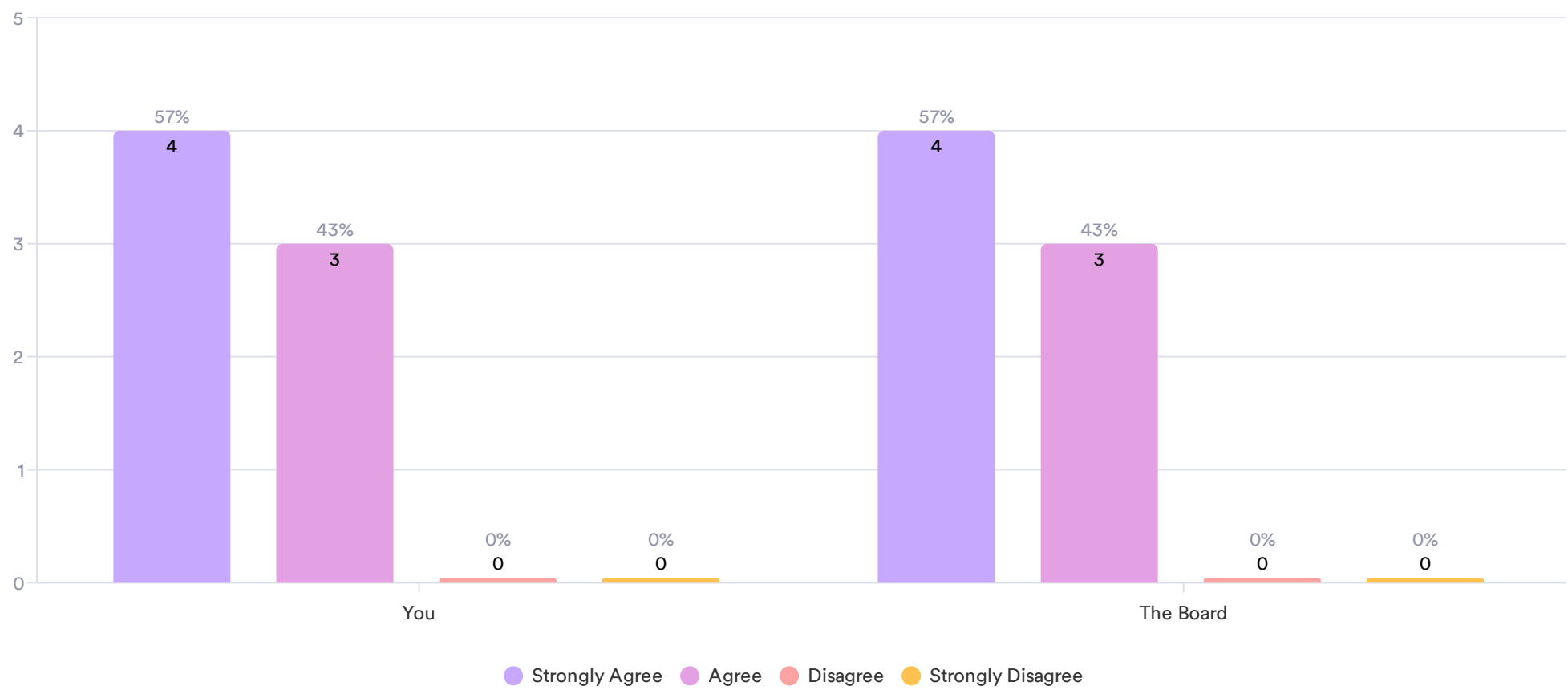

# Effective Leadership: Roles and Responsibilities of the Board

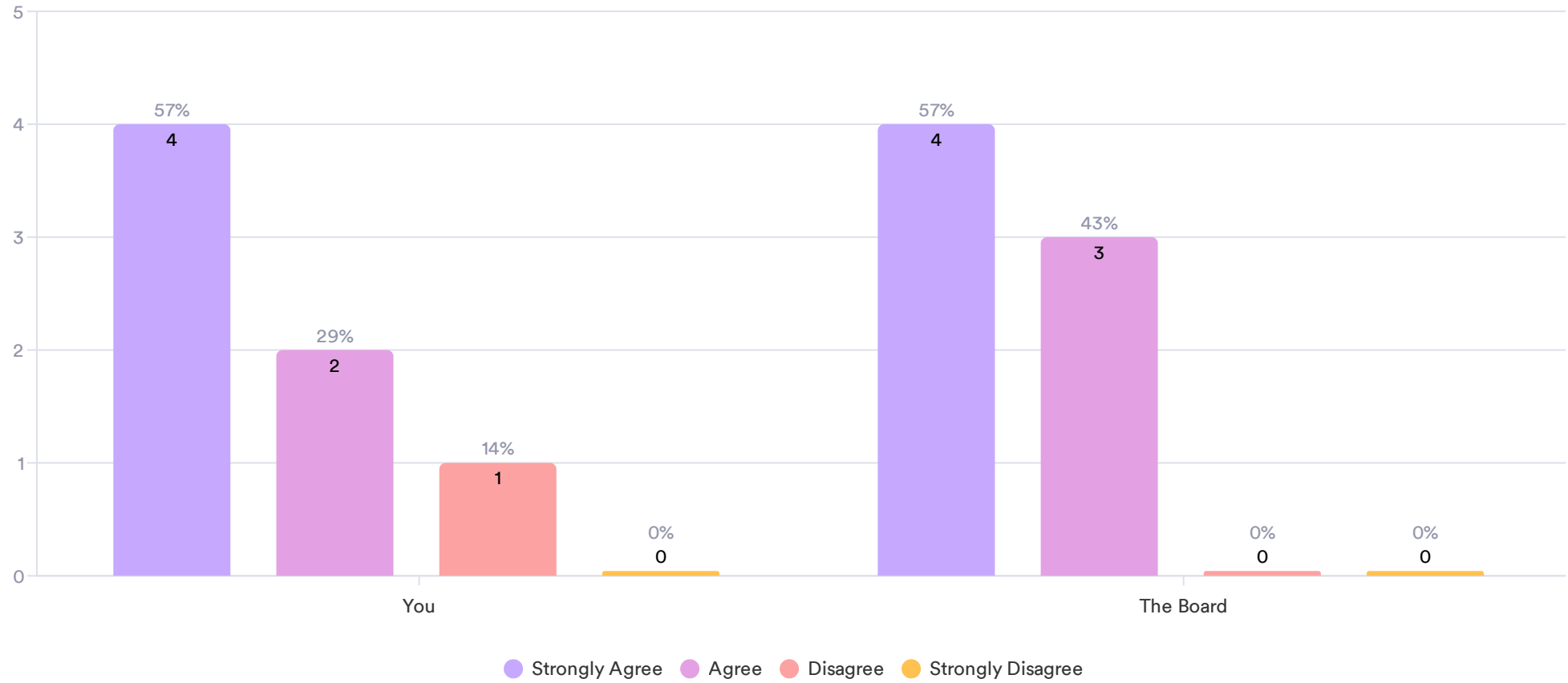
1. The Board understands its roles and responsibilities.

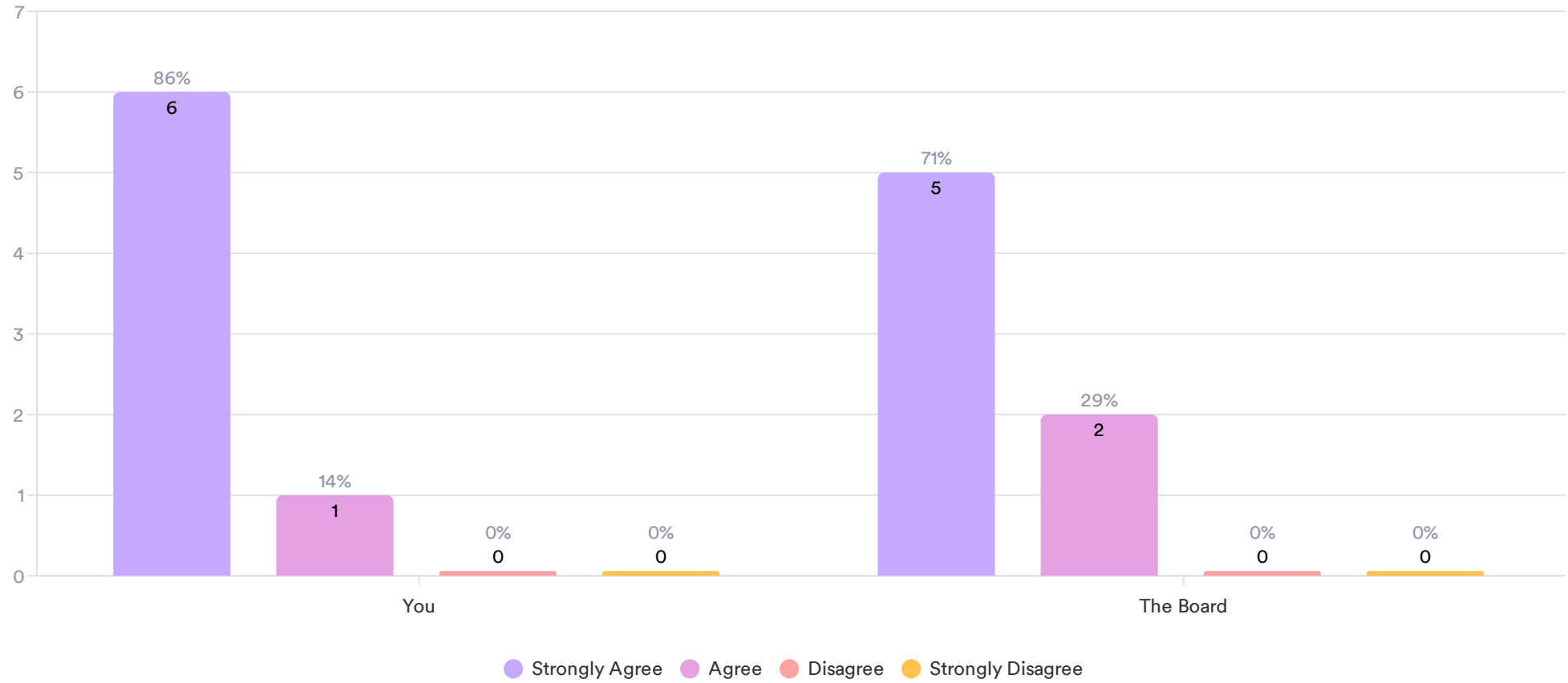

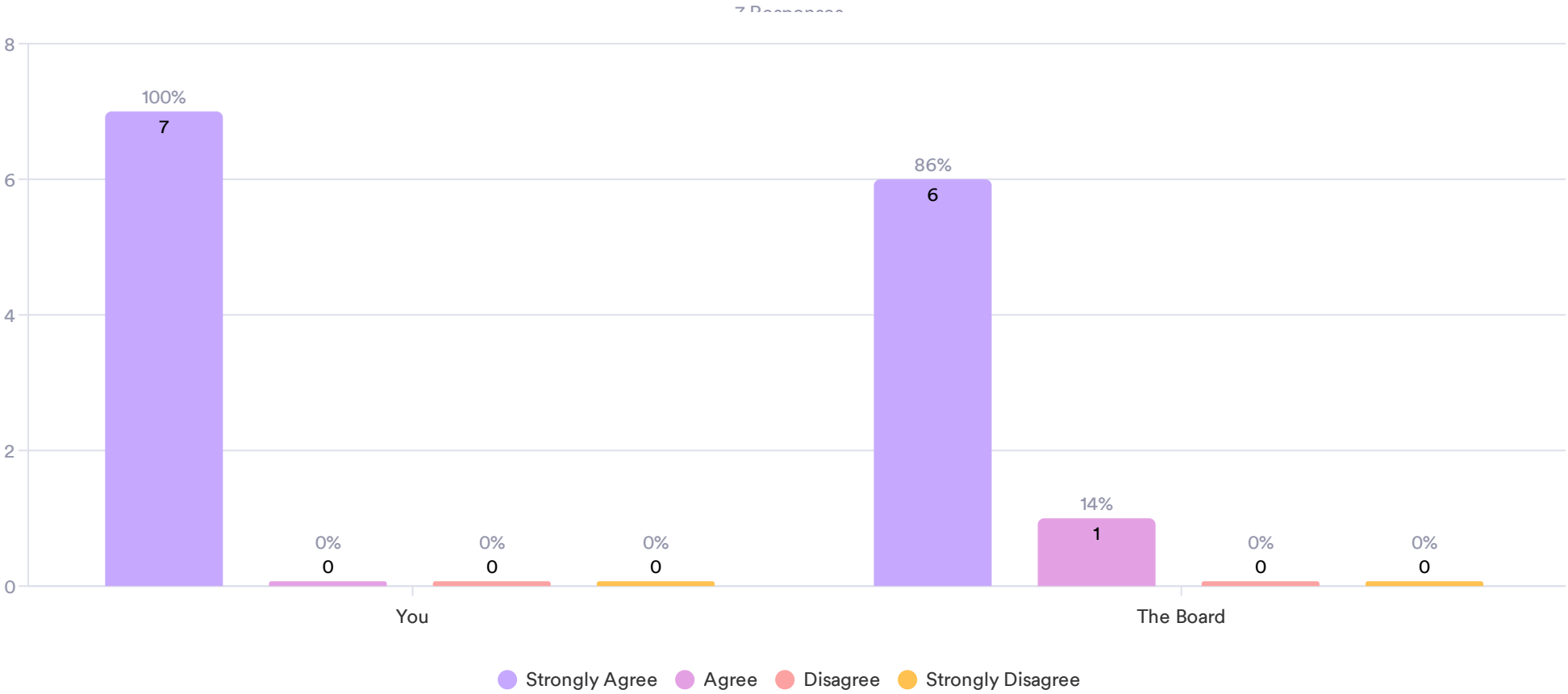

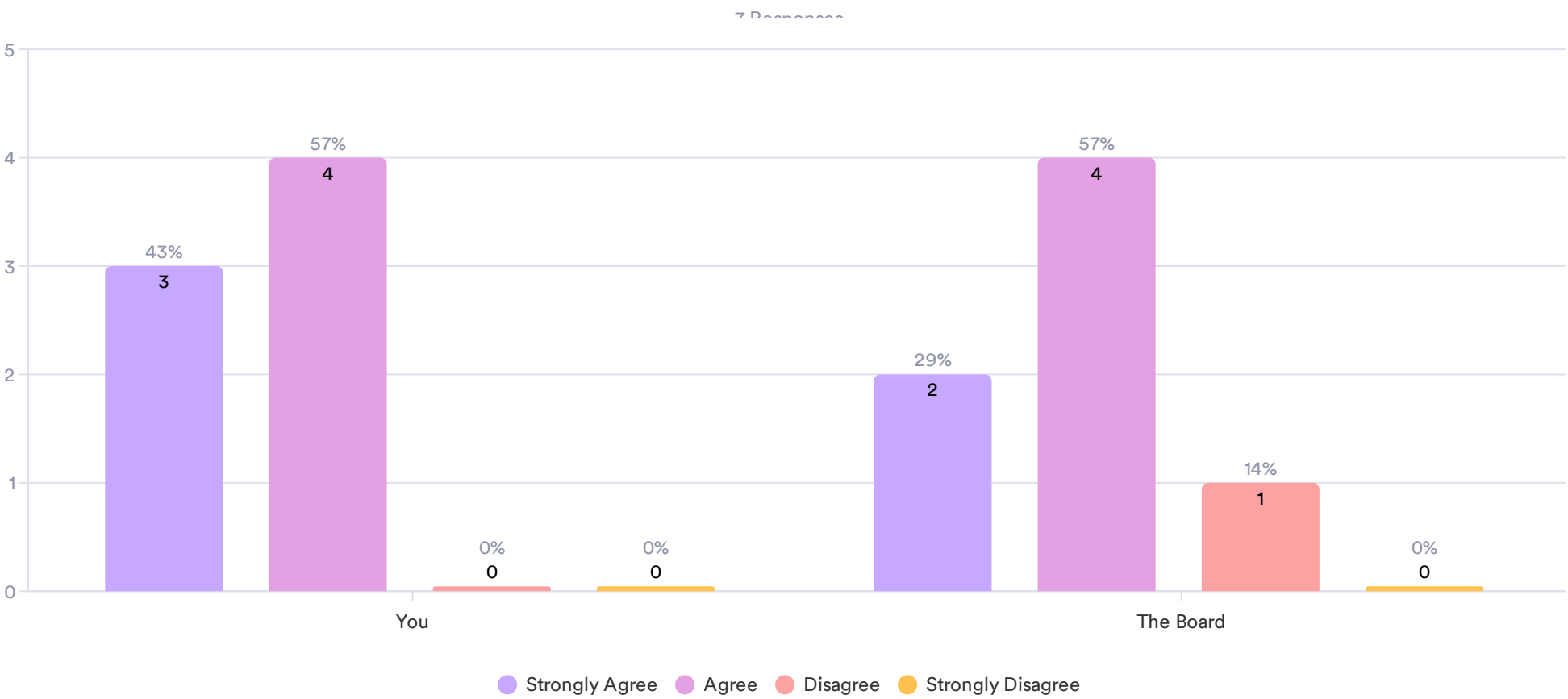

4. The Board understands that the primary function of the board is to establish the policies by which the Community College is to be administered.

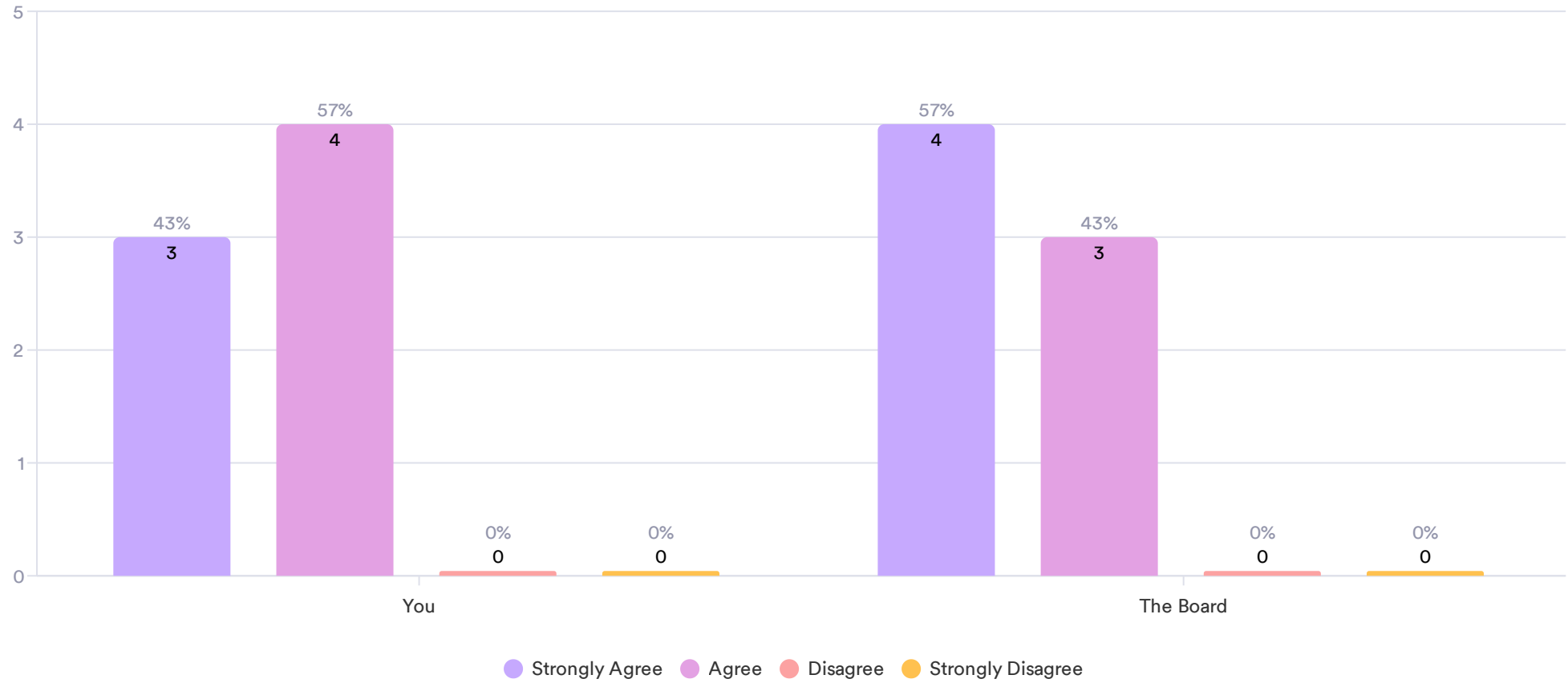


5. Individual Board members bring forth matters relevant to their respective zones as well as county-wide, and the Board as a whole represents the "voice" of the community.

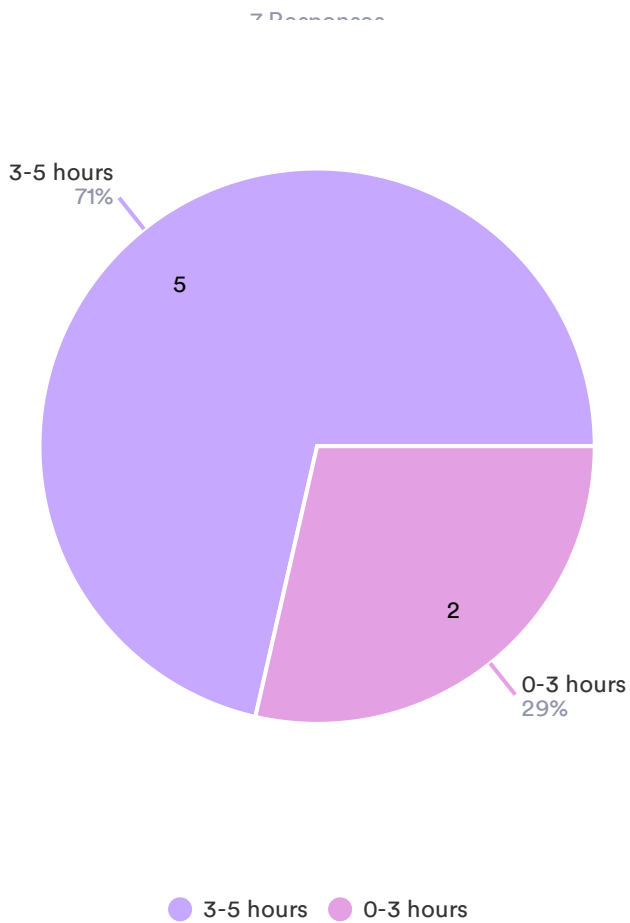


6. Board members devote time, thought, and study to the duties and responsibilities of a community college board member.

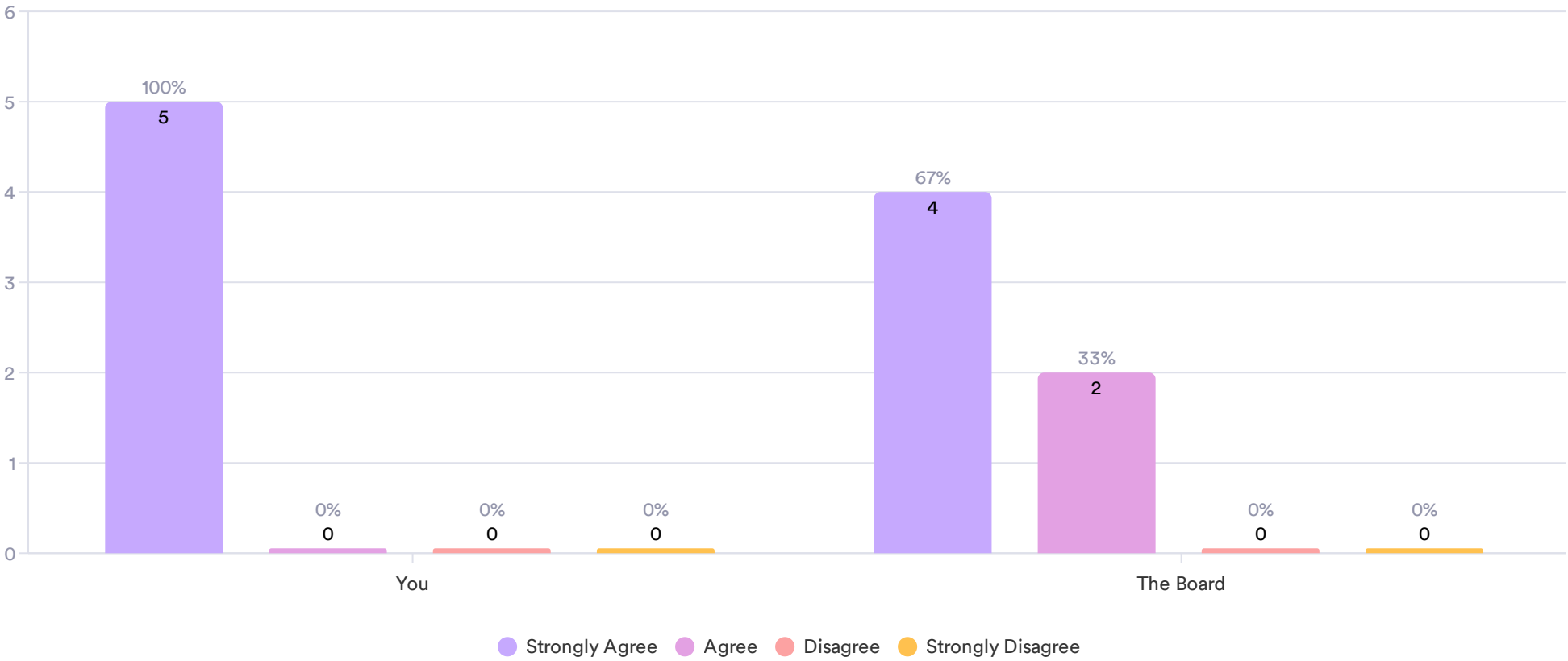
7. On average, I spend the following amount of time per month in my Board duties (including meeting prep, Board meetings, committee work, representing the College in the community):



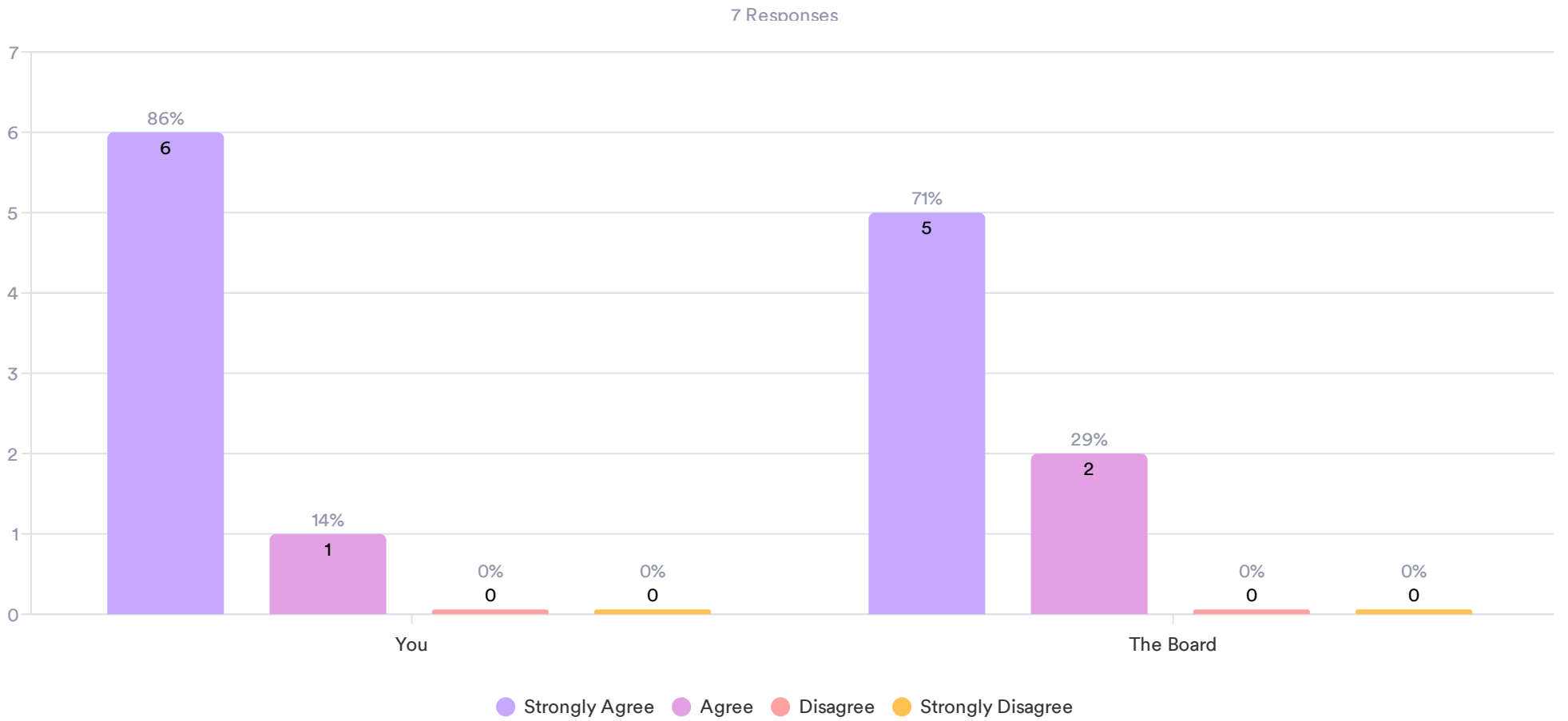


8. Board members maintain confidentiality of topics discussed in Executive Session (if you have not yet participated in an Executive Session, leave blank).

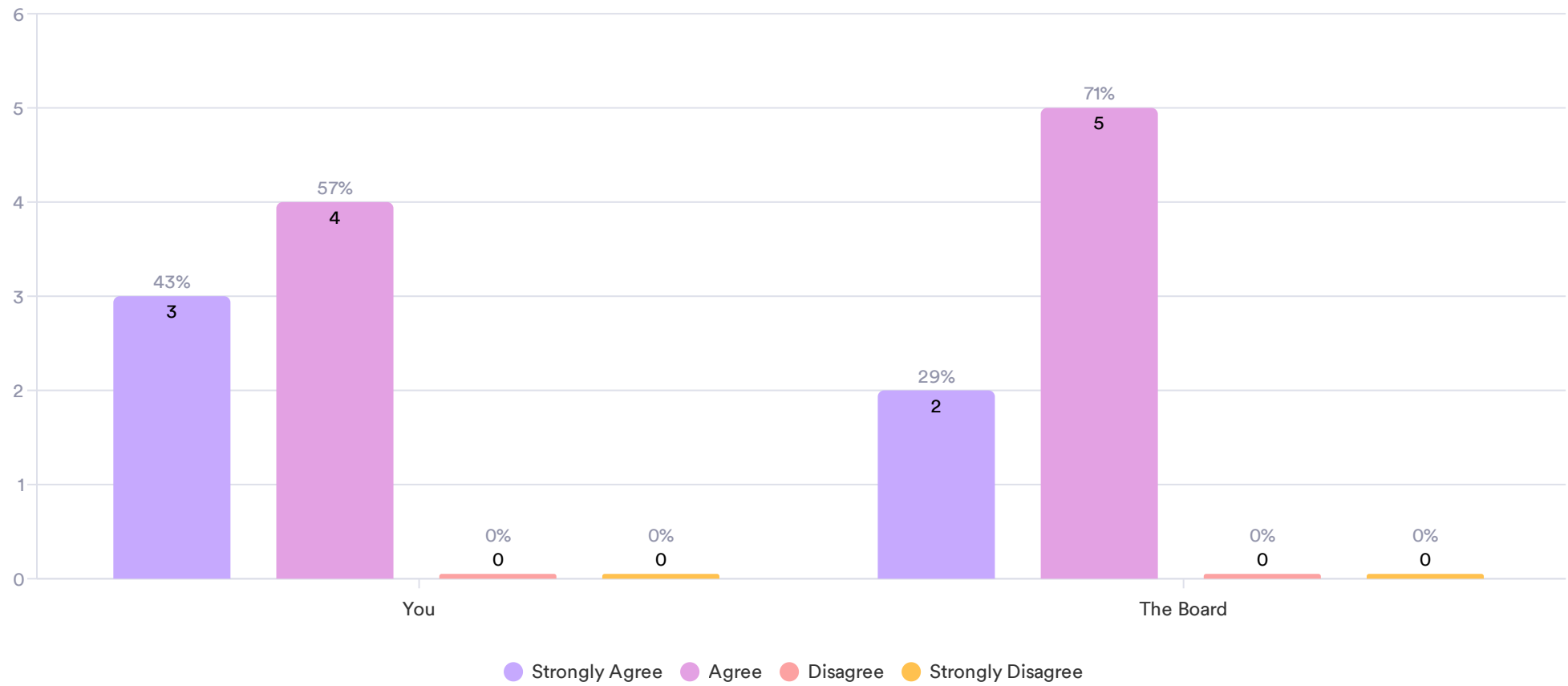


9. Board members identify and prevent conflicts of interest and avoid actions which could create the perception of conflicts of interest.



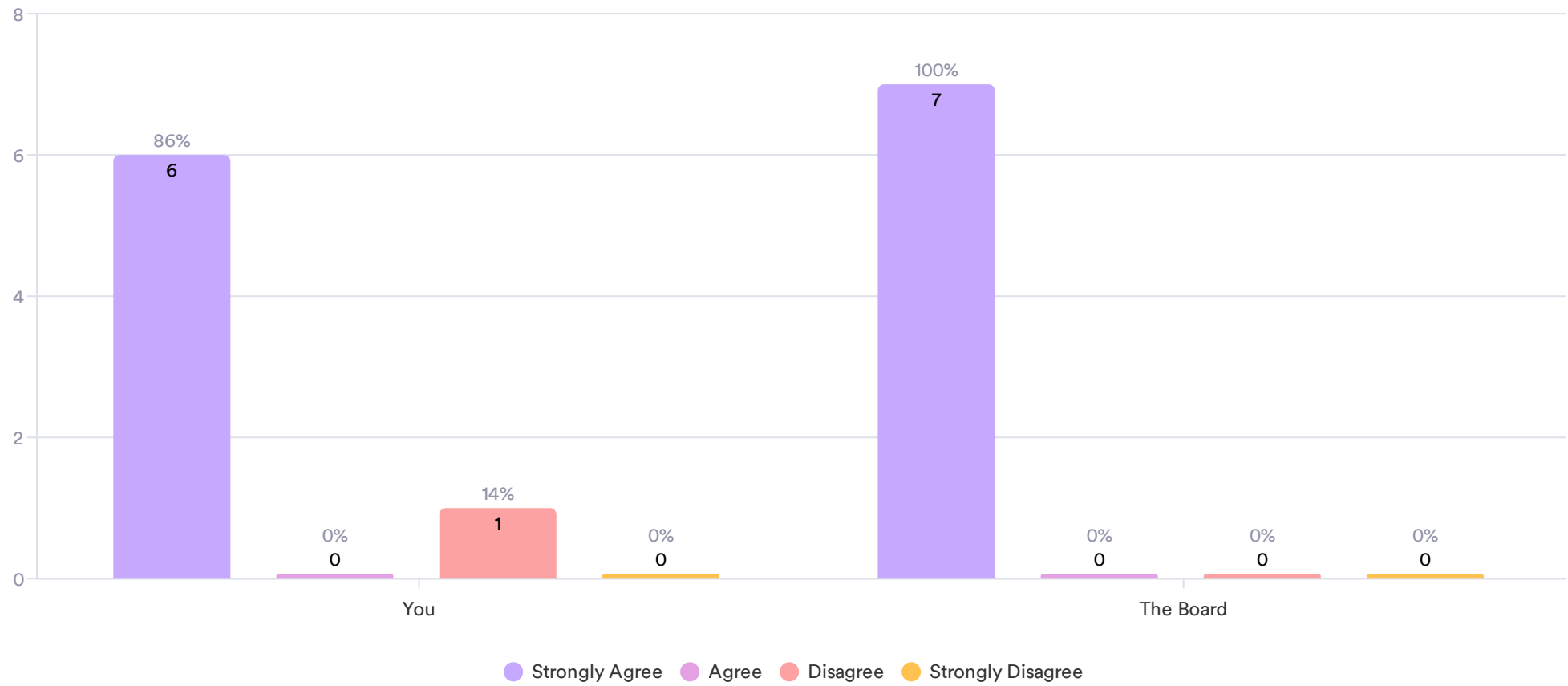

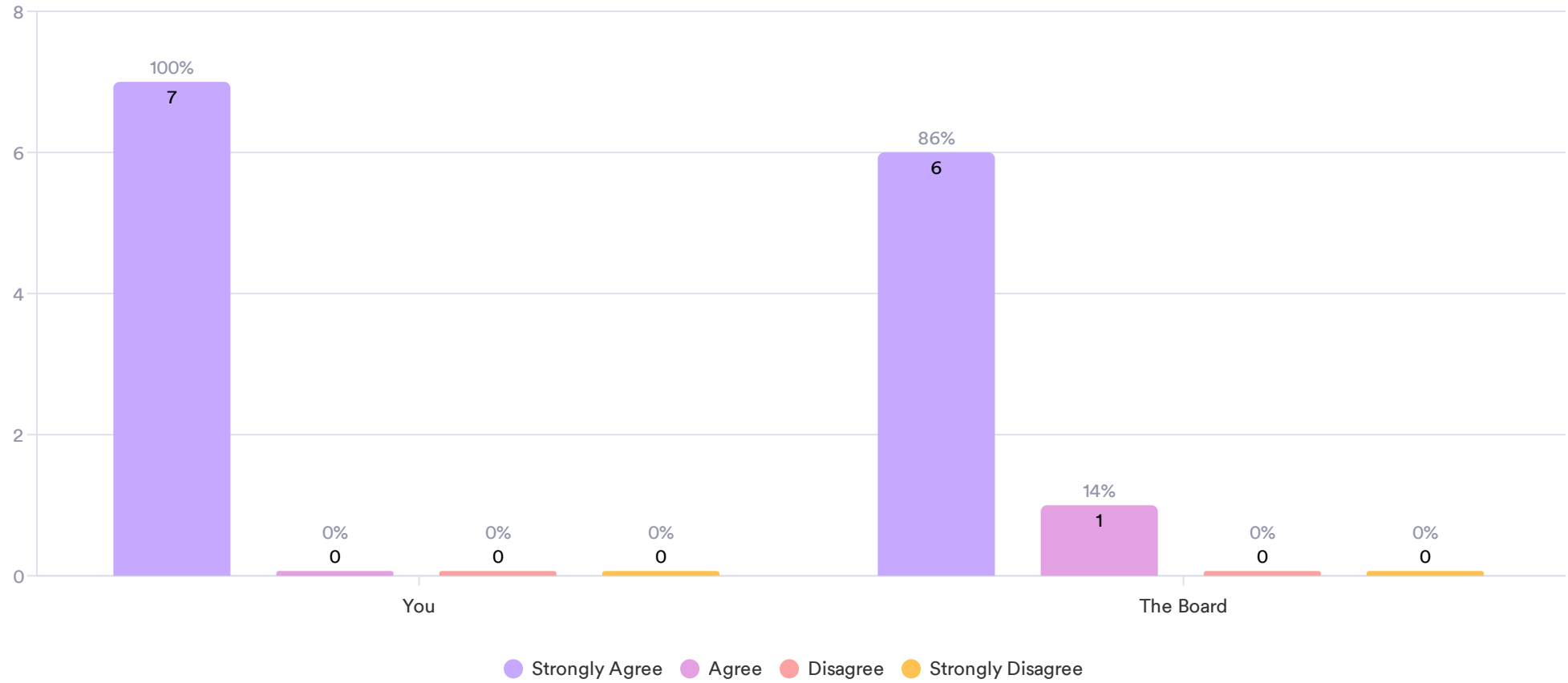
1. Board members treat one another with respect.

1. The meeting agendas are relevant to the work of the Board.

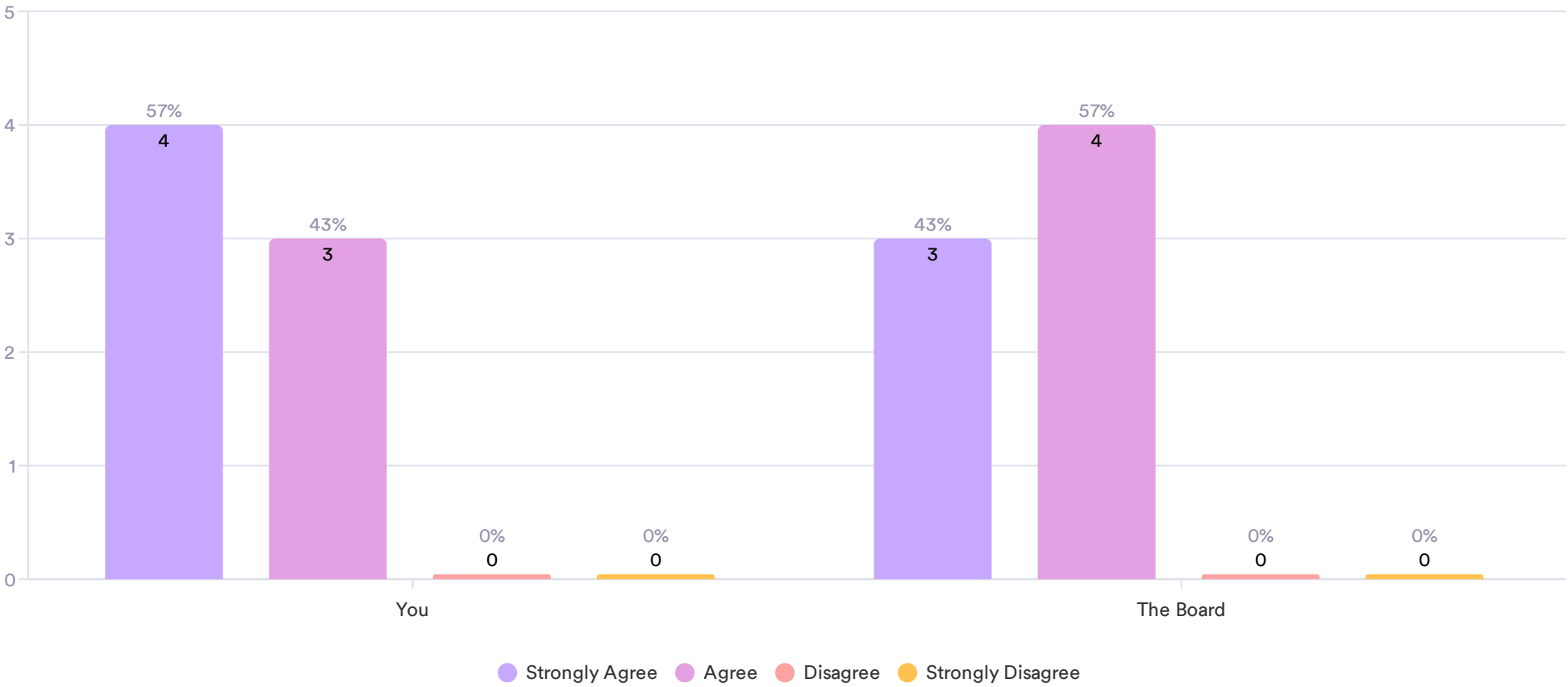

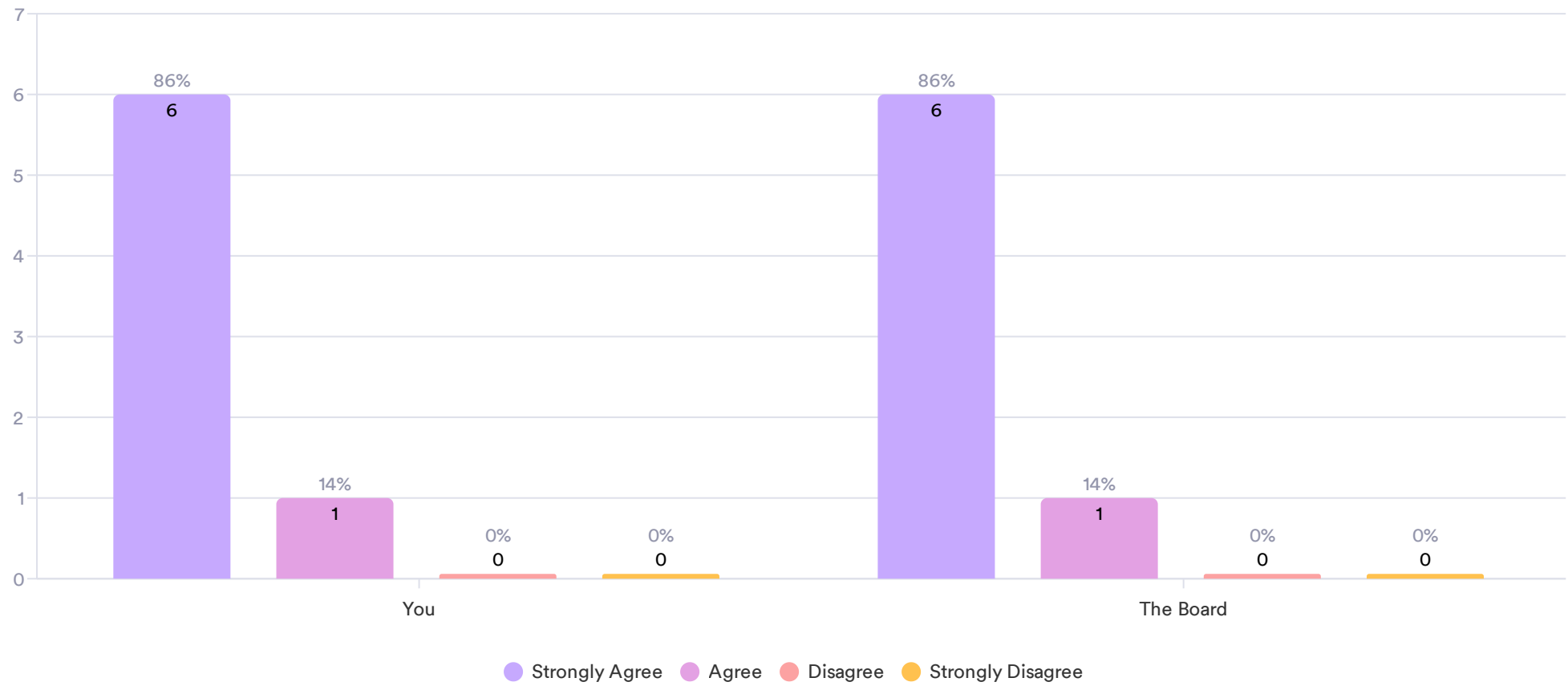
2. Board members are prepared for board meetings.

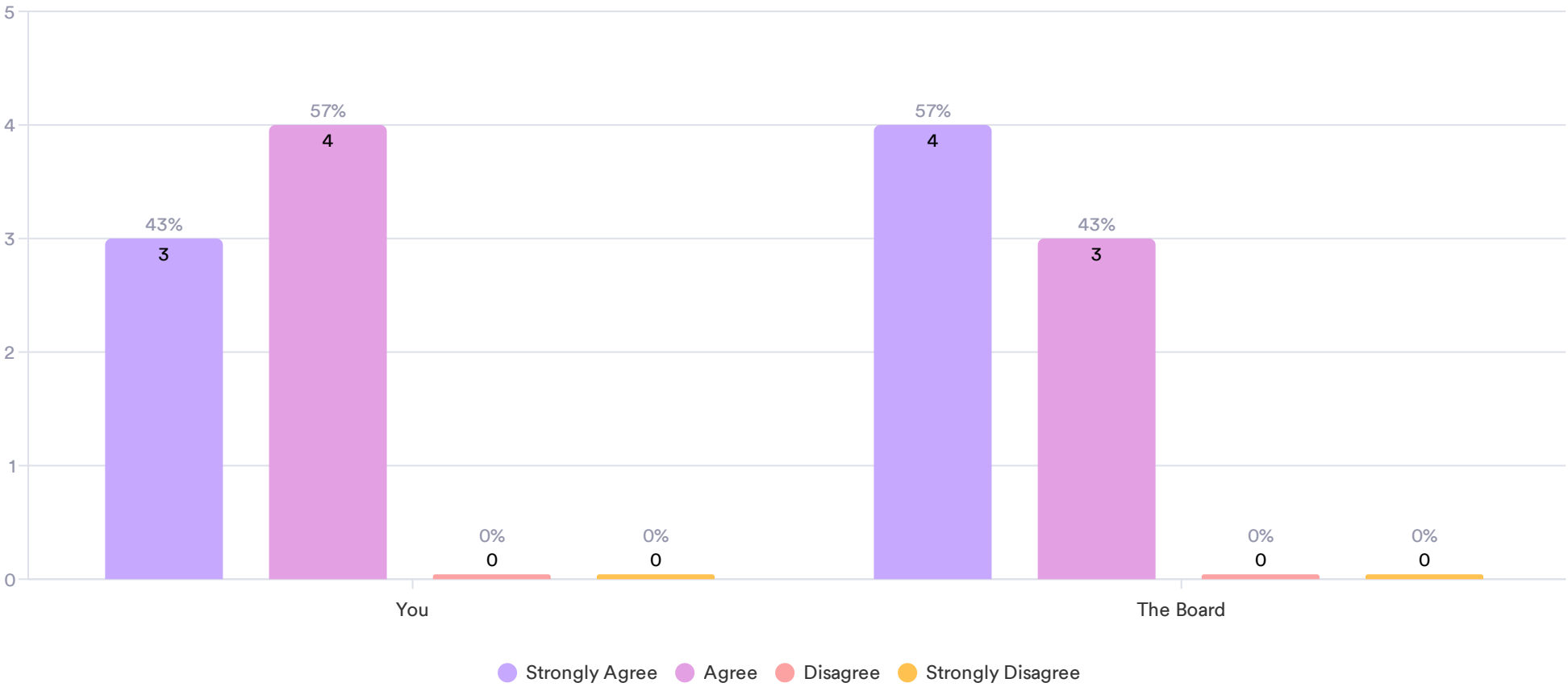
3. Board meetings are conducted in an orderly, efficient manner that allows for sufficient discussion.

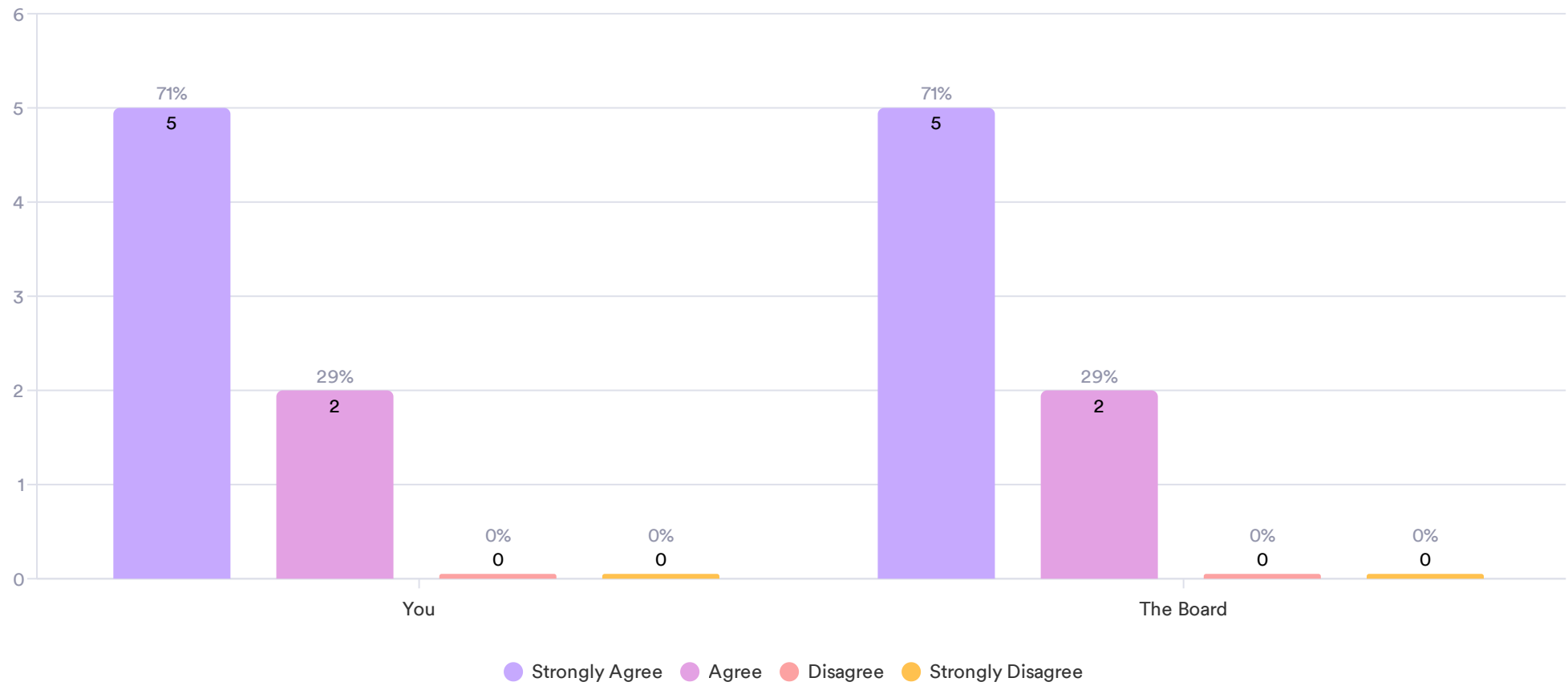
4. The Board regularly identifies priorities in conjunction with the President.

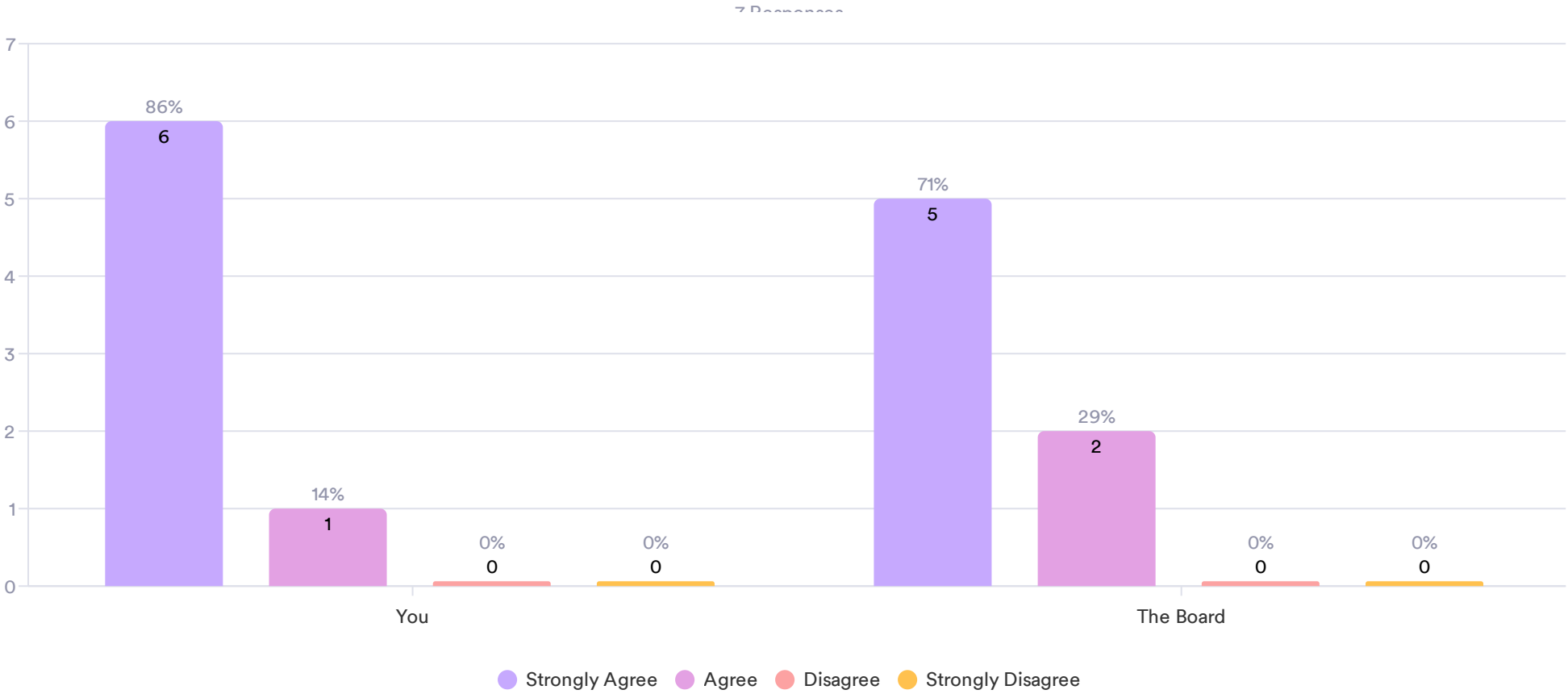

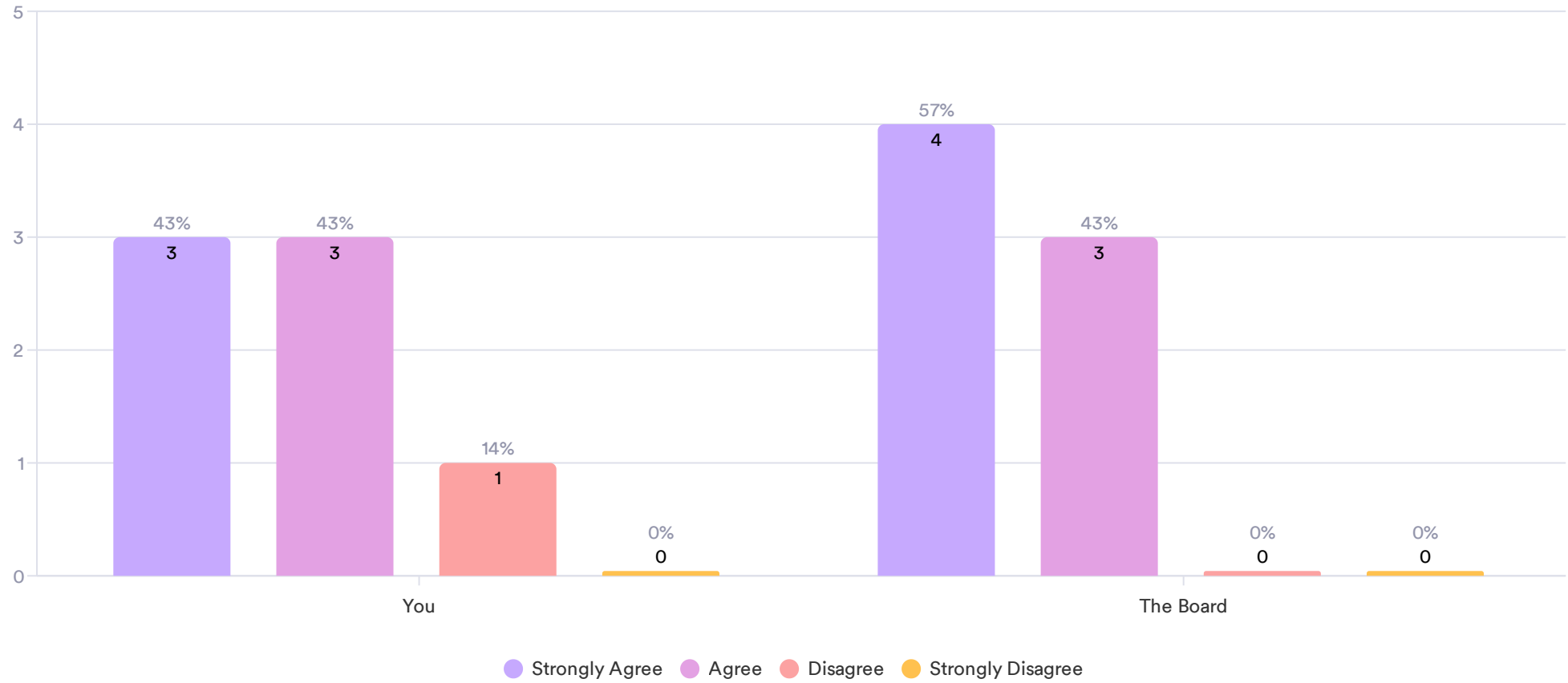


6. The Board agendas and Board questions asked of staff by Board members are relevant to the work of the Board and use the Board and staff's time efficiently.



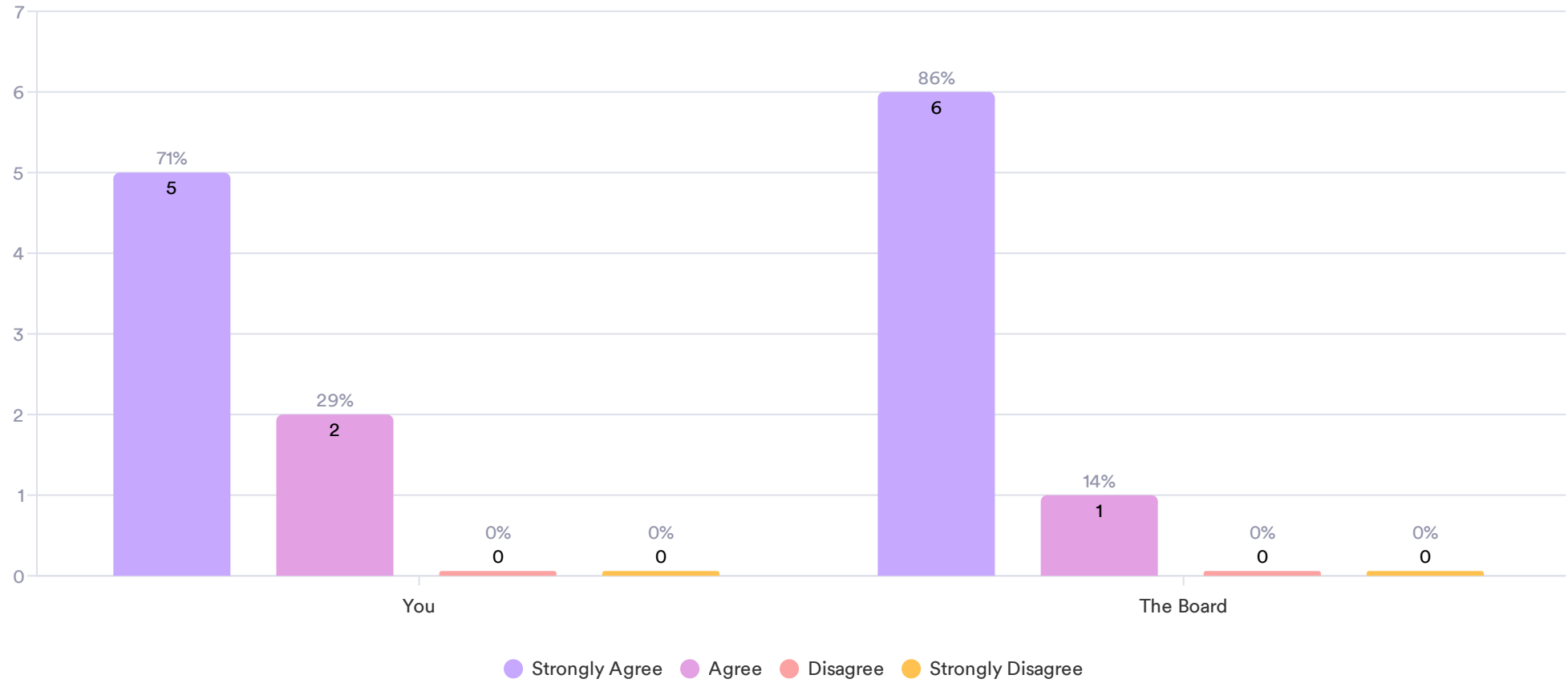
7. The Board is sensitive to the concerns of students and employees while maintaining impartiality and support for the President.

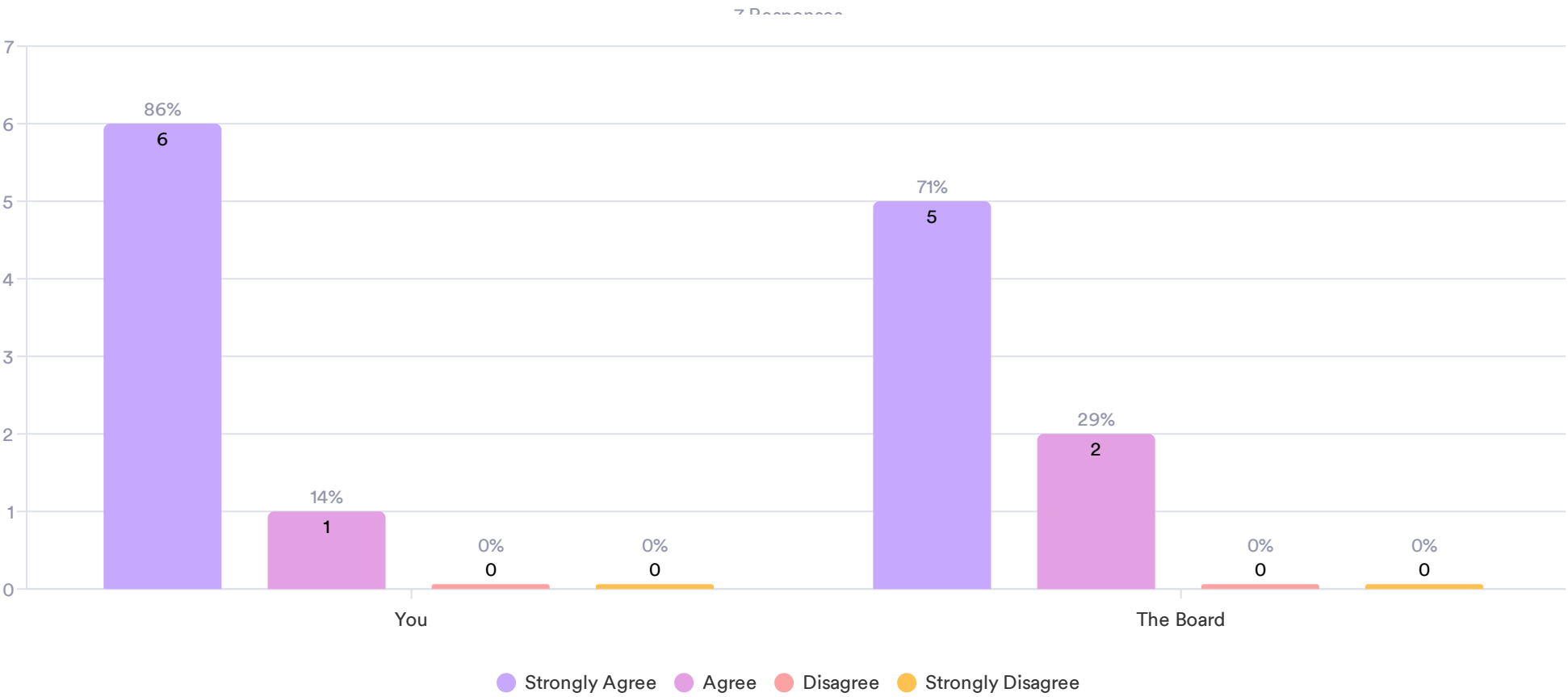


8. The Board periodically reviews and evaluates its own policies and procedures.

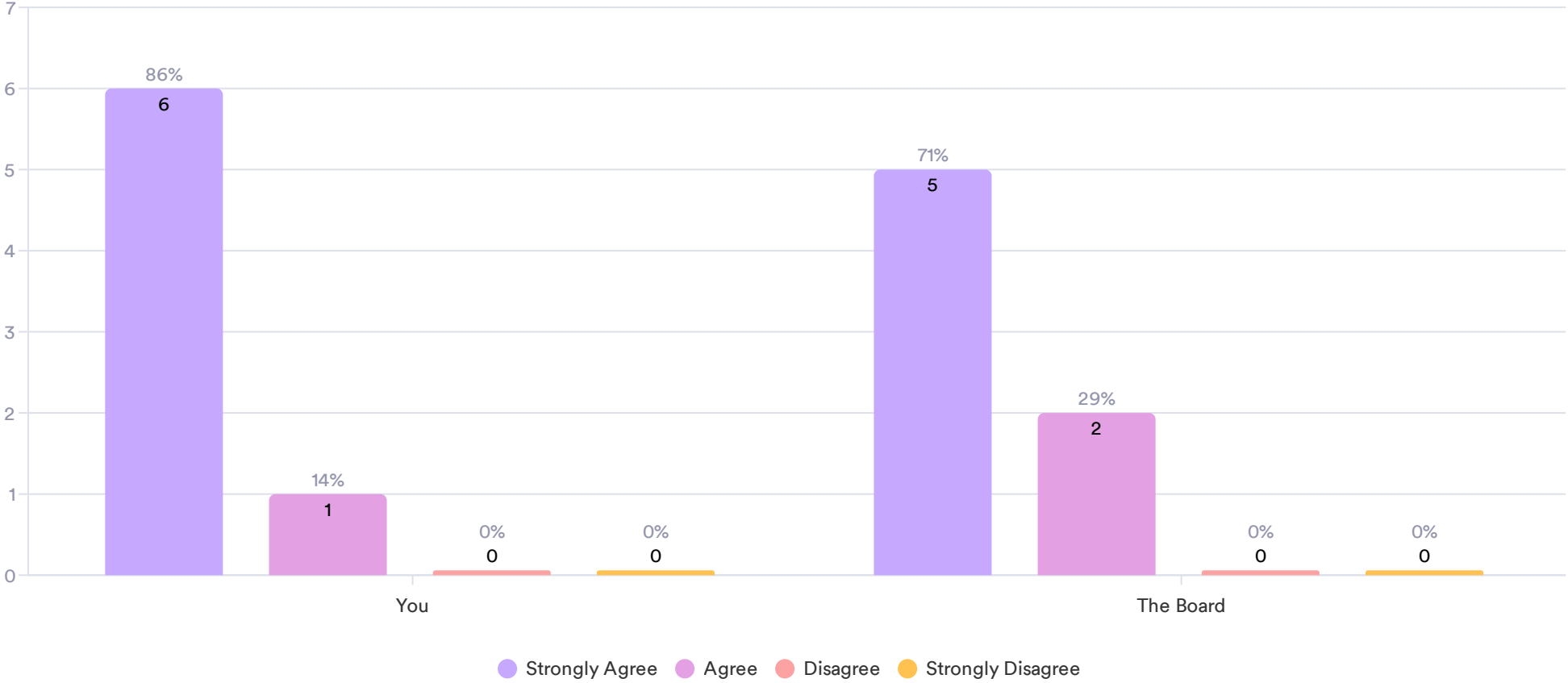
9. The Board accommodates the differences of opinion that arise during debates of issues and once a decision is made, Board members cease debate and uphold the decision of the Board.
