College Services Fee: This fee provides a General Fund offset for costs such as student printing, processing of admission applications and graduation, parking, facilities and grounds upkeep, contracted safety services and emergency preparedness.

Student Success Fee: This fee provides a General Fund offset for costs related to the Math Tutor Center, placement testing using Alex for Math and Accuplacer for Reading and Writing, student success and retention activities, outreach activities and Developmental Education Acceleration projects.

Student Government Fee: This fee provides funds to Student Government for hosting of welcoming and student connection activities, leadership development opportunities and support of Phi Theta Kappa and other club activities.

Technology Fee: This fee provides a General Fund offset for costs related to the implementation and maintenance of a new student management system and MyOregonCoast portal, Microsoft Office 365 licensing for student use, maintenance of College email accounts for all students, maintenance of the learning management system - Canvas, help desk services for students, ongoing maintenance and improvements to the computer labs and Commons area computers and the purchase of equipment for student use and enhanced course delivery.
