\* The Nursing Assistant program is a limited entry program that is typically offered in the Fall, Winter and Spring term. The course may not be offered or may be cancelled for low enrollment or other factors such as faculty availability.

<b><u>Apply to OCCC</u></b>	After receiving the welcome email from our college, follow the instructions to set up your college email and accounts.
<b>Book Advising Appointment</b>	<a href="#"><u>Advising - Oregon Coast Community College</u></a> The advisor for nursing & allied health can assist with general advising, orientation sign up and answer other questions.
<b>Know Your Payment Plan</b>	OCCC's Nursing Assistant Program is not financial aid eligible as a standalone program. There may be other payments options, please discuss them during your advising appointment if you are unsure.
<b>Nursing Assistant Application</b>	The NA application will be posted on the nursing assistant web page for each term that it is being offered.
<b>Avamere Employee Applicants</b>	This population should still follow the above steps in addition to working with their supervisor.
